**SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

1. TEXAS STATE LAW REQUIRES each student to receive all required immunizations listed below and to have a compliant and updated copy in the school office for the child to be allowed to attend school. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.
2. Should your child be exempt from ANY immunizations, a State issued, notarized "Letter of Exemption" is required before your child is allowed to attend school.
3. Both new AND returning students must submit a current up-to-date immunization record.
4. ALL immunizations must be completed and the updated records MUST be turned into the office no later than **July 15, 2010**.

**\*\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE THE CHANGES FOR THE 2010/2011 SCHOOL YEAR AND HOW THEY APPLY TO YOUR CHILD. ALL CHANGES AFFECT EITHER K - 1<sup>st</sup> OR 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> GRADES.**

**ALL STATE REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS**

**\*\*\*\*DIPHTHERIA/PERTUSSIS/TETANUS (DPT):** 5 doses of any combination of DTaP/DTP is required for all students unless the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. Students 7 years of age or older are required to have at least 3 doses of a tetanus/diphtheria-containing vaccine, provided at least 1 dose was administered on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. All students entering **7<sup>th</sup> grade** will be required to have 1 booster dose of the Tdap vaccine if it has been 5 years since their last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine. A booster dose of Tdap is required for **grades 8-12** if it has been 10 years since their last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine.

**ORAL POLIO VACCINE (OPV) or INACTIVATED POLIO VACCINE (IPV):** 4 doses are required with 1 being received on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; 3 doses meets the requirement if the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**\*\*\*\*MEASLES/MUMPS/RUBELLA (MMR):** Beginning with the 2010/2011 school year, all students entering **K - 1<sup>st</sup> grade** are required to have 2 doses of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine. For **2<sup>nd</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> grade** the requirement is 2 doses of a measles-containing vaccine, and 1 dose each of rubella and mumps vaccine.

**\*\*\*\*HEPATITIS A VACCINE:** All students entering **K - 1<sup>st</sup> grade** will be required to have 2 doses of Hepatitis A vaccine with the first dose received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday.

**HEPATITIS B VACCINE:** All children must have 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.

**\*\*\*\*VARICELLA VACCINE (CHICKEN POX):** Beginning with the 2010/2011 school year, all students entering **K - 1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grades** will be required to have 2 doses of varicella vaccine received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday (2 doses are required if the child was thirteen years old or older at the time the first dose of varicella vaccine was received).

**\*\*\*\*MENINGOCOCCAL VACCINE:** Beginning with the 2010/2011 school year, all students entering **7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grades** will be required to have one dose of meningococcal vaccine.
