SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

- TEXAS STATE LAW REQUIRES each student to receive all required immunizations listed below and to have a compliant and updated copy in the school office for the child to be allowed to attend school.
- Should your child be exempt from ANY immunizations, a State issued, notarized "Letter of Exemption" is required before your child is allowed to attend school.
- ALL immunizations must be completed and the updated records MUST be turned into the school office no later than **August 15, 2011**. **Students in kindergarten, grade 7, and all new students are not permitted to attend class until updated records are received.**

ALL STATE OF TEXAS REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

******DIPHTHERIA/PERTUSSIS/TETANUS (DPT)**: 5 doses of any combination of DTaP/DTP is required for all students unless the 4th dose was given on or after their 4th birthday. Students 7 years of age or older are required to have at least 3 doses of a tetanus/diphtheria-containing vaccine, provided at least 1 dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday. All students entering **7th grade** will be required to have 1 booster dose of the Tdap vaccine if it has been 5 years since their last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine. A booster dose of Tdap is required for **grades 8-12** if it has been 10 years since their last dose of tetanus-containing vaccine.

ORAL POLIO VACCINE (OPV) or INACTIVATED POLIO VACCINE (IPV): 4 doses are required with 1 being received on or after the 4th birthday; 3 doses meets the requirement if the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.

******MEASLES/MUMPS/RUBELLA (MMR)**: All students entering **K – 1st grade** are required to have 2 doses of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine. For **2nd – 12th grade**, the requirement is 2 doses of a measles-containing vaccine, and 1 dose each of rubella and mumps vaccine.

******HEPATITIS A VACCINE**: All students entering **K – 1st grade** will be required to have 2 doses of Hepatitis A vaccine with the first dose received on or after the 1st birthday.

HEPATITIS B VACCINE: All children must have 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.

******VARICELLA VACCINE (CHICKEN POX)**: Beginning with the 2010/2011 school year, all students entering **K - 1st and 7th - 8th grades** will be required to have 2 doses of varicella vaccine received on or after the 1st birthday (2 doses are required if the child was thirteen years old or older at the time the first dose of varicella vaccine was received).

******MENINGOCOCCAL VACCINE**: Beginning with the 2010/2011 school year, all students entering **7th – 8th grades** will be required to have one dose of meningococcal vaccine.
